The State of Alabama,
Shelby County. Whereas an Execution issued
from the Chancery Court of Shelby County, against
James D. Hardy in favor of Barnes & Lynn on a
judgement rendered in said Court at the September
Term thereof 1890, for the sum of three hundred and
forty three & 95/100 Dollars besides costs of suit,
which said Execution came into my hands as
Sheriff of said County on the 8th day of November
1893, to execute and return according to law; and
whereas, divers other Executions issued from the said
Chancery Court of said County were also placed in
my hands against said James D. Hardy to execute
and return according to law as will appear by reference
to the records of said Court, by virtue of which Execution
above recited, as also the other said Executions, I do
as Sheriff aforesaid, levy upon the following real property
of the said James D. Hardy to wit: all that tract
or piece of land in the town of Calera Alabama
reserved from sale made by J. D. Hardy to R. J.
Wolt for the Caledonia Land Co described as follows:
Beginning at the intersection of Patton St with
Montgomery Ave at the South West corner at a Stake estab-
lished by the Dare Survey near the Presbyterian Church
thence West on South side of Patton St to an ally East
of Barnes lot thence South on East side of said ally
& across Adams St to the school house lot thence East
along North line of school house lot to its line thence
South on said school house lot East line to lot
sold to a Mr Evans thence East on Evans North line to
Montgomery Ave thence North along Montgomery Avenue

and across Adams street to place of beginning; of which
 said levy then and there notice was given defendant personally;
 and the said property so levied on, after having been duly
 advertised for sale by giving thirty days previous publication
 of the time, place and terms of sale, in The Shelby Sentinel,
 a newspaper published in said County, and also by posting
 at the Court House Door of said County an advertisement
 of said sale for thirty days previous, was offered for sale at
 Columbia, in front of the Court House door in said County
 between the legal hours of sale, on the 3rd Monday in
 December being the 18th day thereof, 1893 at which said
 sale James D. Gunn became the purchaser of said
 property so levied on as aforesaid, for the sum of Six
 hundred and Eighty five Dollars, he being the highest
 best and last bidder for the same. Now Therefore, know
 all men by these Presents; That for and in consideration
 of the premises, and of the payment by said James D. Gunn
 of the said sum of Six hundred & eighty five Dollars,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I do hereby
 sell, convey, transfer and set over to the said James
 D. Gunn, all the legal right, title, interest and claim
 which the said James D. Hardy had and held in and to
 the foregoing described premises. Witness my hand this
