

Wright, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and for the further consideration of One hundred and Sixty 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ Dollars, with interest thereon from this date, to be paid on the 12th day of April A.D. 1896, and the further sum of One hundred and Sixty 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ dollars, with interest from this date, to be paid on the 12th day of April A.D. 1897, and for which credit payments etc the said J. W. Wright has this day executed and delivered his two promissory notes, secured by mortgage of even date herevict for the land herein described, has granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said J. W. Wright the following land, to wit:



The North half of North East quarter (Lots C and D) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township twenty (20) south, range two (2) east, containing eighty 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ (80.26) acres, more or less, designated on plan hereon, in Shelby County, State of Alabama.

To have and to hold, the said described lands, together with any improvements thereon, and the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said J. W. Wright his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever, But it is distinctly understood and agreed that the Alabama Mineral Land Company excepts from this conveyance and saves to itself, its successors and assigns, the exclusive right and title to all the Coal, Iron, and other Minerals in or on said land, together with the right of entry on said lands to prospect for minerals in and all necessary privileges for mining on said lands, and also the right of way for trail or tramways for mining purposes through any portion of said lands,
