Com Shelby County, I know all now by these present
to that whereas, J. G. W. Canturberry, the undersigned Commissioner,
Reynolds, hitherto appointed by the Honorable Probate
Court of said County to sell certain lands hereinaf-
ter described for partition between H. S. Latham,
Lizzie B. Sparrow, Electa J. Stovre, Jno J. Stovre
adults and Jno A. Fletcher Alice Fletcher and her-
trude Fletcher minors, joint owners of said land,

Gertrude Fletcher had at the date of said sale and now
have in and to the property aforesaid. To have and to hold
unto the said Heber & Keywoed, their heirs and assigns
