 and affection we bear to the said Clara D. Black our
 mother, we, Laura Belle Davidson and C. Thomas
 Davidson, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the
 said Clara D. Black the following described real
 estate, to wit: The certain lot or parcel of land lying
 and being in the town of Calera on the corner of Garden
 and Orchard Streets being one hundred feet front on
 said Garden Street and one hundred feet on said
 Orchard Street, said lot lying between parallel lines.
 Also lots numbered Eighteen (18) and nineteen (19)
 in the Orchard allotment of the town of Calera the same
 fronting on Patton Street one hundred and twenty (120)
 feet and on Dant Street one hundred and fifty (150)
 feet. Also that certain real estate in said town of
 Calera known as "Black's Shop" Also the North East
 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) quarter of the South East (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) quarter of Section
 Eleven (11) Township Twenty two (22) of Range Three (3)
 West. Also the South half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East (SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
 quarter Section Fourteen (14) Township Twenty two (22)
 of Range Three (3) West. Also seven (7) acres of land
 more or less in the South East (SE) corner of the
