I know all men by these presents:

grant bargain sell release and confirm and convey unto

tate lying in the County of Shelby State of Alabama to wit:
Commencing at a point Two hundred feet East of North-
West corner of Block A Dares Map of Calera, and on
South side of Gordon Street. Thence run South One
hundred and eighty feet more or less - thence East
fifty feet, thence North One hundred and eighty feet
more or less. Thence West along South Margin of said

Gardner Street fifty feet to front of beginning Lyng
 and being in the town of Calera, Shelby County, State of
 Alabama. To have and to hold the foregoing premises
 to the said Elias Williams his heirs and assigns for-
 ever. And I do command with the said Elias
 Williams his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully sig-
 ed in full of the foregoing premises; that they are free
 from all encumbrances; that a good right to see
 and carry the same to the said Elias Williams his
 heirs and assigns: and that I will warrant and de-
 fend the premises to the said Elias Williams his heirs
 and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and
