

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we W. G. Parker and A. E. Parker husband and wife

for and in consideration of Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars,
 paid in hand by A. P. Longshore,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant, bargain, sell,
 and convey unto the said A. P. Longshore,
 all of that part of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 24 that lies on the
 S.E. side of the Southern Railroad except about 4 acres in the South west
 corner of said section sold to Maggie Mardis and Eliza Mardis
 and N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ and eight acres bounded as follows commen-
 cing at the S.E. corner of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ and running East
 to the Columbian and Wilsonville Public road thence North
 East along said road to the cross fence between Mason
 and W.G. Parker hence along said fence in a North West
 direction to the line between the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the
 S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ except 5 acres off the East end of said
