

yards. Thence North seventy yards, thence west sixty
four yards to Montgomery road. Thence running
a South west direction along the Montgomery road
seventy nine & a half yards to point of beginning.
Containing one acre or more or less, and being a
part of 10. W. 1/4 of M. W. 1/4 sec-6-T-21 Range 2 East.
