


The State of Alabama, Shelby County.

 and convey unto the said J H Lovelady the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant, bargain, sell,
 and convey unto the said J H Lovelady the following described property, to-wit: Commencing at the SW corner of the NW
corner of S E 1/4 & S E corner of the G A Bennett lot above
running west fifty feet thence a northerly direction about
two hundred & ten feet thence east fifty feet to the NW
Corner of School lot thence south back to starting point
the above described lot of land is located in the S E 1/4 of
the N E 1/4 of Section five Township 22 Range 3 West situated
in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama and in
the corner of Dogwood Ala and bounded south by the
Tuscaloosa Celeste Road and west by G A Bennett and
sixth north by Isaac Powell & east by School lot and
Durham lot



situated, lying, and being in the County of Shelby, and State of Alabama.
