This instrument is not to be construed, however as any release or modification in any particular whatever of my rights and claims to the bonds of the said L. A. Hardy and J. D. Hardy acquired by me through a certain mortgage executed to me by the said Hardys on the 10th day of March, 1900. Said mortgage being recorded in Volume 53, P. 422 in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Ala. this last named mortgage being taken to cover all preceding indebtedness for the part of the Hardys to me, and in lieu of the preceding mortgages named.
