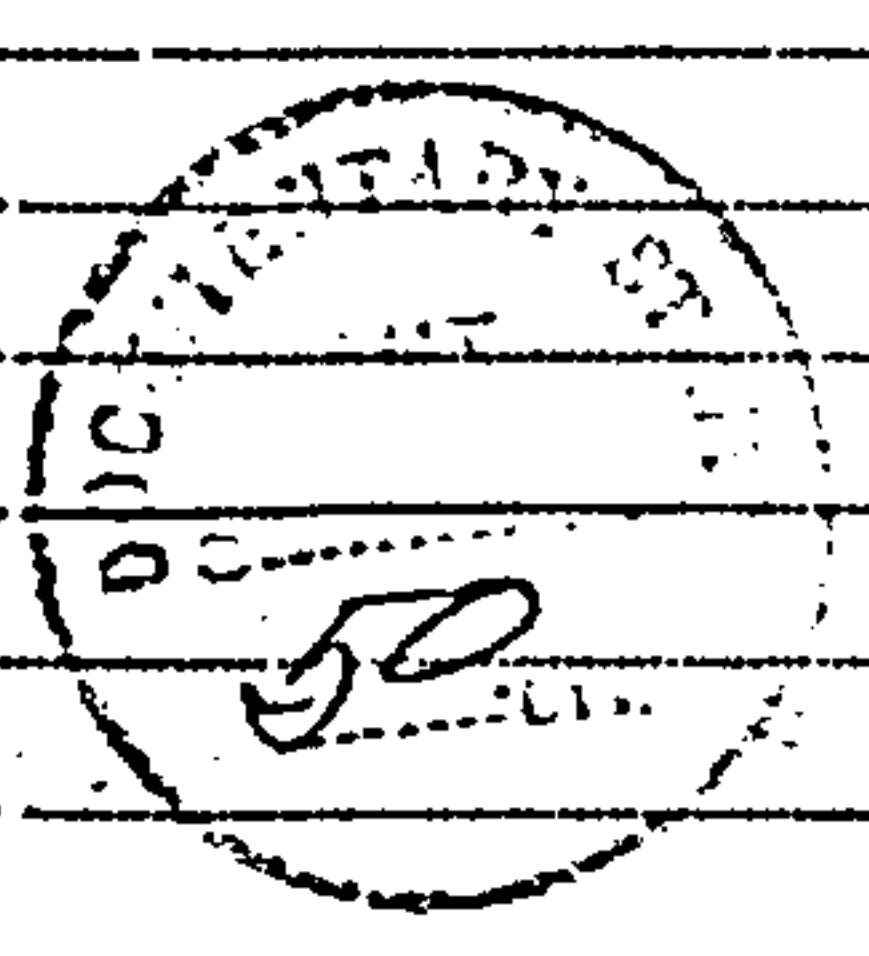

the following described real estate to wit:

Commencing at the South West Corner of the land now
owned by said A M Cross which the same joins the land
now owned by R A Stoll on the Section line men-
ing North and South dividing Section four Township
Twenty four Range twelve east - thence north along
said section line eight hundred feet - thence in a south
easterly direction five hundred and forty two feet
to the Monticello & Selma dist Road; thence in a
South westerly direction along said dist road six
hundred and forty eight feet to point of beginning
Containing four & 10/100 Acres more or less
