

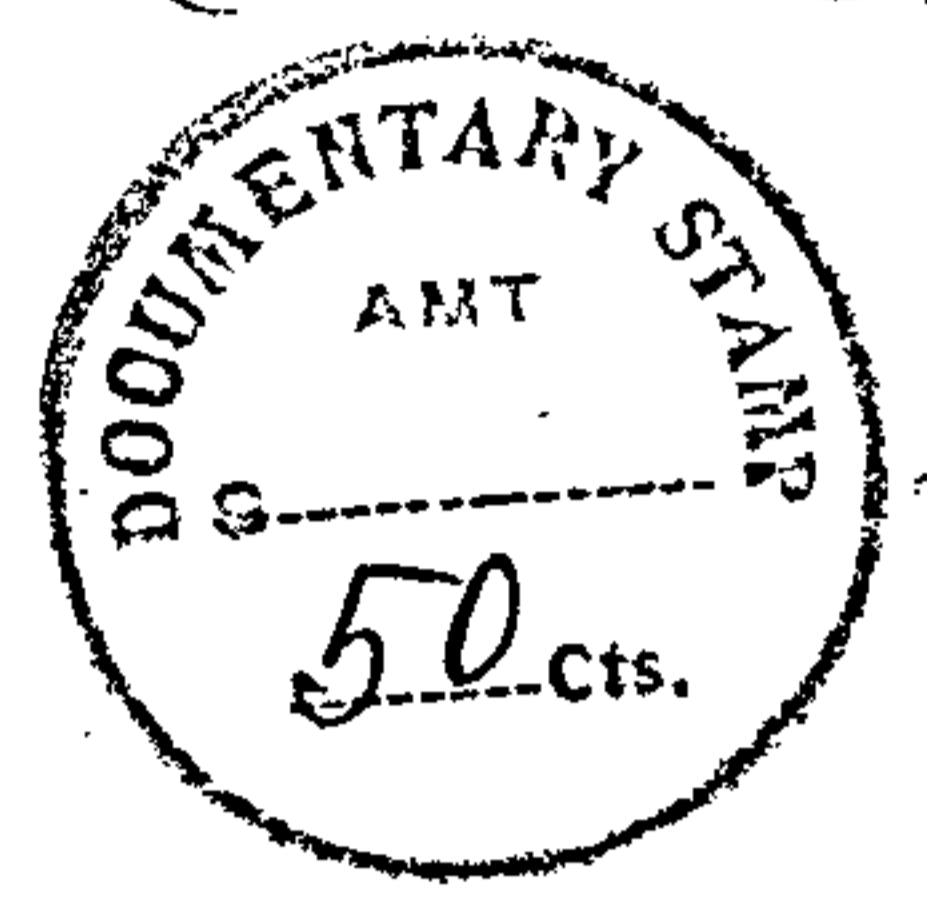

 situated in the County of Shelby and State of Ala-  
 bama to wit: The South half (S<sup>2</sup>) of the South  
 east fourth (S<sup>4</sup>) of Section (35) Thirty five  
 Township Twenty one (21) Range Two (2) west  
 containing Eighty acres more or less to have  
 & to hold the aforegranted premises to the said  
 Mrs. Mattie C. Thrasher her heirs and assigns  
 forever. And we do covenant with the said  
 Mrs. Mattie C. Thrasher her heirs and assigns  
 that we are lawfully seized in fee of the  
 aforegranted premises; that they are free from  
 all incumbrances; that we have a good right  
 to sell and convey the same to the said Mrs.  
 Mattie C. Thrasher, her heirs and assigns for  
 ever, against the lawful claims and demands  
 of all persons.
