Now therefore in consideration of the premises  
and for the purpose of correcting the error made  
by us, in the former deed and at the sum of  
One Doller to us in hand paid by the said R.A.  
O'Dora the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
we W.H. Kinsley & M.A. Kinsley his wife R.J. Farr  
& A. Farr his wife do hereby grant bargain sell  
and convey unto the said R.A. O'Dora an undi-  
vided one third interest in and to the following  
described real estate to wit: One lot house & lot  
in the town of Wilsonville Alabama, beginning  
at the south east corner of Depot lot on the right  
of way of the Southern Railway, formerly the  
Selma Rome ~~Pine~~ & Dalton RR. thence east 24  
degrees north along said right of way thirty  
five (35) yards; thence north 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  degrees, west  
seventy yards; thence west 24 degrees, south  
thirty five (35) yards; thence south 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  degrees

last Seventy yards (70) to point of beginning  
on said right of way being in the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4  
of section 6, Township 2, Range 2 East.

To have and to hold unto the said R.A. O'Dera  
his heirs and assigns forever; and we do covenant  
with the said R.A. O'Dera his heirs and assigns  
forever; and we do covenant with the said  
R.A. O'Dera that we are lawfully seized in fee


