

R. F. Cox The State of Alabama Whereas an execution issued
 Sheriff Shreve County from the Circuit Court of
 to Shreve County against J. E. R.
 Martin M. Davidson in favor of Martin Leonard on a judgment
 rendered in said Court on the 24th day of September
 1896, for the sum of Two hundred and thirty three & 24/100
 Dollars, besides costs of suit, which said Execution
 came into my hands as Sheriff of said County
 on the 1st day of July, 1902, to execute and return ac-

 said property so levied on as aforesaid for the

 Dollars, the being the highest best and last bidder
 for the same. Now therefore I do witness all this
 by the present - That in pursuance of the
 premises, for and in consideration of the said sum of
 three hundred and twenty six & 00/100 Dollars to me,

in hand paid by the said Mattie M Leonard the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged I R. F. Cox as Sheriff
of said County do hereby sell Convey transfer and deliver
to the said Mattie M Leonard all the title interest and claim
which the said J. E. R. Doudson had held & owned in
in and to the foregoing described premises as fully and
completely, in all respects, as I might lawfully or ought
to convey the same under and by virtue of the power
and authority vested in me in the premises & by the
Statutes for such cases provided, To him & to his heirs and assigns for-
