 To Shelby County. Know all men by these presents,
 Addie Johnson That I, Sallie Byrd, for and in Consideration of Five hundred dollars, to me in hand paid by Mrs Addie Johnson, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, enfeoff and Convey unto the said Addie Johnson, the following described real estate to-wit: at Shelby Springs in said County - Commencing at the Forks of the Columbiana & Montevallo road and the Shelby Iron Works road, thence along said Columbiana & Montevallo road fifty-two (52) yards - thence one hundred & fifty-five (155) yds at right angles from said road parallel to the said Shelby Iron Works road, thence fifty-two (52) yds to the said Shelby Iron Works road, One hundred and sixty-five (165) yards to place of beginning, being the lot upon which is now known as the Varnon or John Byrd lot at said Shelby Springs.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Addie Johnson. And I do covenant with the said Addie Johnson, her heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all encumbrance, that I have a good right to sell and convey the same to the said Addie Johnson her heirs and assigns; and that I will warrant and defend the premises to the said Addie Johnson her heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
