man, (who joins herein for the purpose of assenting to and
concurring in this contract by his said wife, as well as to
convey all his right, title, interest and estate in and to the
lot hereinafter conveyed,) parties of the first part, and
Laura L. Ogley, party of the second part, witnesseth:
That for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred
dollars in hand paid by said party of the second part,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said parties
of the first part, have granted, bargained and sold,
and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and con-
vey unto said party of the second part, the following
described lot or parcel of land lying and being in the
town of Montevallo, in said County and State, to-wit:
Lot number One W in Block M. of Lyman's Addition
to Montevallo, according to the map of said Lyman's
Addition as recorded in the Probate Office of said
County, the said lot number One, fronting on

Nabors Street one hundred feet and running back along
Moody street one hundred and fifty feet.

To have and to hold
together with all and singular the right, privileges, tenements
and hereditaments thereunto belonging or appertaining unto
the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns
forever. And said parties of the first part hereby con-
venant with said party of the second part that they are
lawfully seized of the aforesigned premises, that they have
a good right to sell and convey the same and that
they will warrant and defend the title to the same to
said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns,
against the lawful claims or demands of any and all
persons whomever, either at law or in equity.
