 real estate town:

All of the N 2 of N E 4 of S W 4 of section  
 33 Township 18 Range 2 East, with the exception of a  
 strip across the west end, of said N 2 of N E 4 of S W 4  
 ninety yards in width and containing four acres, the  
 tract containing sixteen acres, more or less. And also  
 a tract of land containing six and one half acres  
 more or less, having for its western boundary the right  
 of way of the spur track of the Central of Georgia Railway  
 from the point where said spur track crosses the line  
 dividing the S E 4 of N W 4 from the N E 4 of S W 4 to the  
 point where said spur track crosses the line dividing  
 the N W 4 of the N E 4 from the S W 4 of the N E 4 of section  
 33 Township 18 Range 2 East, and for its eastern boundary  
 a line extending thence to the S W 4 of the N E 4 and the  
 S E 4 of the N W 4 of said section and parallel to the western  
 boundary, said tract being of the uniform width of  
 seventy yards and containing as aforesaid six and  
 one half acres more or less. Also the following  
 described tract of land on the southern boundary  
 of the S E 4 of the N W 4 of said section 33 Beginning

To have and to hold to the said Tennessee Coal Iron & Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, forever.

And we do for ourselves, executors and administrators, covenant with the said Tennessee Coal Iron & Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Tennessee Coal Iron & Railroad Company, its successors and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
