KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Alabama Mineral Land Company, a corporation chartered and doing business in the State of Alabama, under the laws thereof, in consideration of Six Hundred (\$600)-- Dollars to it paid by Justin C. Jackson receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Justin C. Jackson all of the saw timber, that is timber measuring Fourteen (14) inches or more in diameter at the stump or base measured two feet above the ground on North East quarter of north east quarter, west half of southwest quarter, southeast quarter of southwest quarter of south west quarter and south half of south east quarter --- of section twenty five (25) town ship nineteen (19) South Range One (1) east containing two hundred and thirty nine & 97/100 acres more or less, in Shelby County state of Alabama upon the condition named herein.

The cutting of the saw timber from said land may commence at once and must be completed within twenty four (24) months from this date, and all of said saw timber which has not been cut and removed by the date named shall revert to and become the property of the grantor; and the occupancy of said lands by said grantees is expressly limited to the time stated and for the purpose of cutting said saw timber only.
