to furnish us merchandise
during the year 1903 not to exceed the sum of
thirty five Dollars, now in order to secure the pay-
ment of said indebtedness and merchandise agreed
to be furnished ~~we~~ we do hereby waive all
claims or rights of exemption under the Constitution

and laws of the state of Alabama; and we do hereby
convey, sell and convey unto W.S. Brown, his
heirs and assigns, the following described property, to wit:
our crops of cotton, corn, wheat, oats and potatoe planted
or to be planted, grown or to be grown during
the year 1903, in Shelby County, Alabama; also all
my interest, right or claim in my tenants, rentes
and children's crops raised or to be raised in
said County during said year; also one
gray mare, 2 years old called Doe, one

" mule 9 " " John, one
Black milk cow - " Lady, one
yellow " " Heifer

If we fail to pay said indebtedness and mer-
chandise to be furnished, and cost of this deed
by the first day of November 1903, or if we sell,
or attempt to sell, any of said property, or move
or attempt to move the same from the limits
of Shelby County, then W.S. Brown, his agents or
assigns, are authorized to take possession of said
property and sell the same at private sale if
he deems best, or after giving five days' notice
by poster in two public places in Shelby County
to sell the same for cash, and with the proceeds
to pay said indebtedness and the cost of this
deed together with all the cost and expense
of taking possession and selling said property
and the balance to pay to the undersigned.

W.S. Brown, or his agents or assigns, are author-
ized to purchase any or all of said property
at the sale thereof under this deed.
