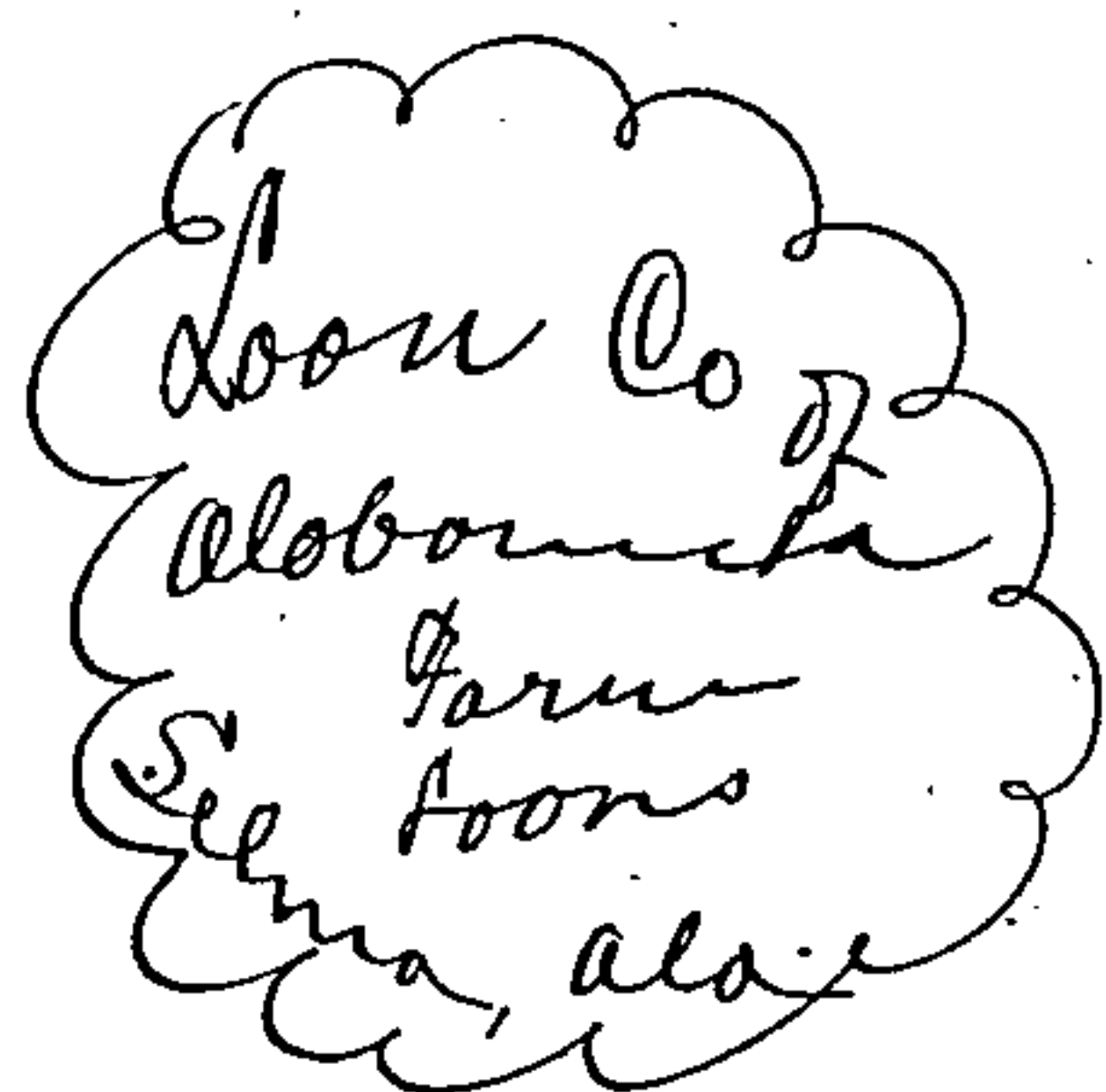


Know all men by these presents: That whereas
 B. F. Thomas and E. R. Isbell of Shelby County, Alabama,
 did on the first day of June 1900 execute and deliver
 to T. B. Roy a certain Mortgage on the following described
 lands, lying and being in said County of Shelby State
 of Alabama, to wit: North half & North East quarter
 of section Four, Township eighteen, Range one
 East. Also South East quarter of South West
 quarter, and North East quarter of South West
 quarter and South East quarter of North West quarter
 and North half of South East quarter, except fifteen
 acres in South East corner thereof, in section
 thirty four, Township seventeen, Range one
 East and containing in the aggregate 265 acres
 more or less: which said mortgage was given to
 secure an indebtedness therein specifically described
 and is duly recorded in book 52 of Mortgages, pages
 533 et seq in the office of the Judge of Probate of said
 County of Shelby Alabama, and whereas at the
 same time the said B. F. Thomas & E. R. Isbell gave
 & delivered to the Loan Company of Alabama a second
 Mortgage, on the same land above described
 which said second Mortgage is duly recorded in
 book 52 of Mortgages pages 539 et seq in the office
 of the ~~Probate~~ Judge of Probate of said County, Alabama
 And whereas the said B. F. Thomas & E. R. Isbell having
 failed to pay said indebtedness secured by said
 Mortgages according to the contract, and having
 made default therein, and having failed to
 keep and perform the stipulations and agreements
 entered into by them the said T. B. Roy & the

 Thomas and C. R. Isbell having failed and demanded

 together with a description of the property, which
 said notice was given by advertising the same
 in The Shelby Chronicle a weekly newspaper
 published in said Shelby County, State of
 Alabama, at least three times before the day
 of sale, at which sale John B. Paisley being the
 highest, best and last bidder purchased said
 property at and for the sum of one hundred
 sixty six and $\frac{4}{100}$ Dollars cash. Now therefore
 in consideration of the said sum of one hundred
 sixty six and $\frac{4}{100}$ Dollars, to us in hand paid by John
 B. Paisley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 we J. B. Roy and the said Loan Company of Alabama
 the said Mortgage made and by virtue of the
 power contained in said Mortgage above referred
 to, and with express reference to said power,
 have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these
 presents grant bargain, sell and convey unto
 said John B. Paisley his heirs and assigns, all
 and singular the property herein above described
 together with all the tenements and hereditaments
 therunto appertaining or belonging, but no
 warranty is hereby intended. To have ^{and} to hold
 unto said John B. Paisley his heirs and assigns
 in fee simple forever in testimony whereof
 the said J. B. Roy has hereto signed his name
 and affixed his seal, and the said Loan Company
 of Alabama has caused its signature and

Seal to be attached hereto by its President duly
authorized and empowered so to do, this the 20th
day of July A.D. 1903.

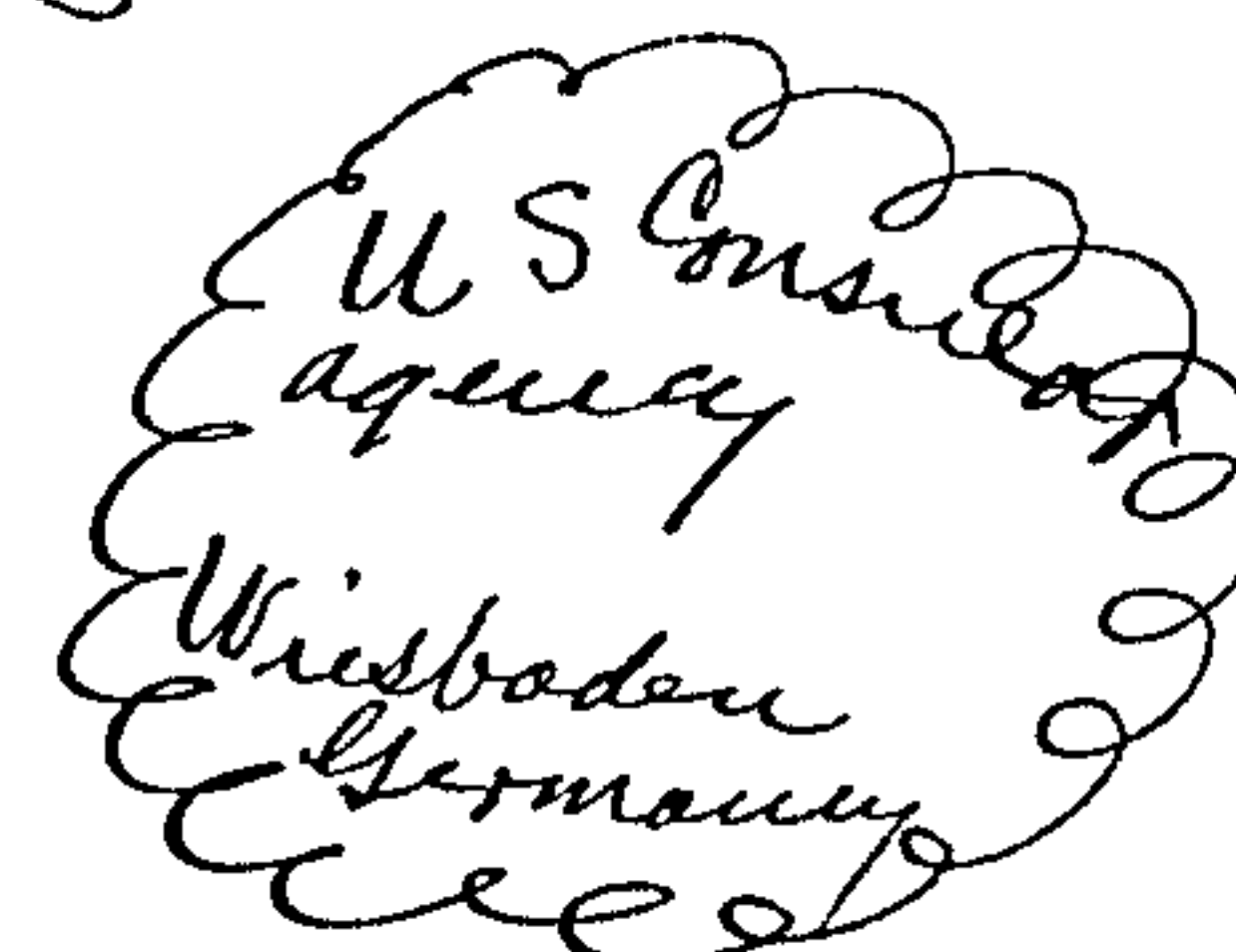
