The north east quarter of the north west quarter of Section

(3) west except all of said forty acres lying north East of
the Montvale and Elyton road and excepting the right of way
and easement noted in the public along and over the

Ashville Road, the tract hereby conveyed containing

and Sarah E. Nobors & Bert Nobors and Mary Lyman and
her husband E. J. Lyman for good and sufficient
consideration to them moving do hereby remise
release, quit-claim and convey unto the said Frank
Moody all their right title and interest and estate
in and to said above granted premises.
