 Sherry County } entered into this 25th of June
 1856 between John Lindsey
 and Malinda Lindsey his wife of the first part Allen
 Harmon of the second part Witnesseth, that & in
 consideration of the sum of One hundred & fifty dol-
 lars to me in hand paid by the said Allen Harmon
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 bargained sold and conveyed unto the said Allen
 Harmon a certain Tract or piece of land being
 and lying in the County & State of aforesaid. Being a
 part of the west half of the south west quarter of Section
 thirty Township twenty of Range three west in the
 District of Tuscaloosa. Being the part of said land
 that lies on the west side of Cohaba River supposed
 to be about twenty five acres, being the same more
 or less, together with all and singular the rights and
 privilege appertaining therunto or in any manner
 To have and to hold to him the said Allen Harmon
 his heirs and assigns forever, from the said John Lindsey
 and Malinda Lindsey his wife their heirs & assigns
 from all and every other person or persons whosoever
 will warrant & forever defend the title of said
 land - to have and to hold forever, & will forever
 defend the said Allen Harmon his heirs and assigns
 forever - acknowledged and subscribed to this day
