Donelson of Shelby County Alabama, have deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the land office at Montgomery whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William C. Buffington Frank J. Smith William C. Riba, George N. Gilmer, Alfred H. Moses and Presley W. Donelson according to the provisions of the act of Congress, of the 24th of April 1820, entitled an act "making further provision for the sale of public Lands" for the West half, the north east quarter and the north half of the south east quarter of Section six in Township twenty-one, of Range three west in the district of land subject to sale at Montgomery Alabama, containing Five hundred and fifty eight acres and eleven hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said William C. Buffington Frank J. Smith William C. Riba, George N. Gilmer, Alfred H. Moses and Presley W. Donelson

Now Know Ye: that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made & provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give ^{and} grant unto the said William C. Buffington, Frank J. Smith William C. Riba, George N. Gilmer, Alfred H. Moses and Presley W. Donelson and to their heirs the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of of whatsoever nature thereto belonging unto the said William C. Buffington Frank J. Smith William

C. Bibb, George N. Gilmer, Alfred H. Moses and Pressley W. Donelson and to their heirs and assigns forever.
