 Eight feet parallel with Cross Valley road Thence East
 100 one Hundred feet Thence North (28) Twenty Eight
 feet to the S. E. Corner of said Chaudler lot Thence West
 100 one Hundred feet along said line to starting point
 situated in Vincent, Shelby County, Alabama.
 To Have And To Hold, To The Said R. P. Tucker And A. W. Tucker
 their Heirs and Assigns forever. And we do, for our-
 selves and heirs, executors and administrators, covenant
 with the said R. P. Tucker and A. W. Tucker their Heirs and

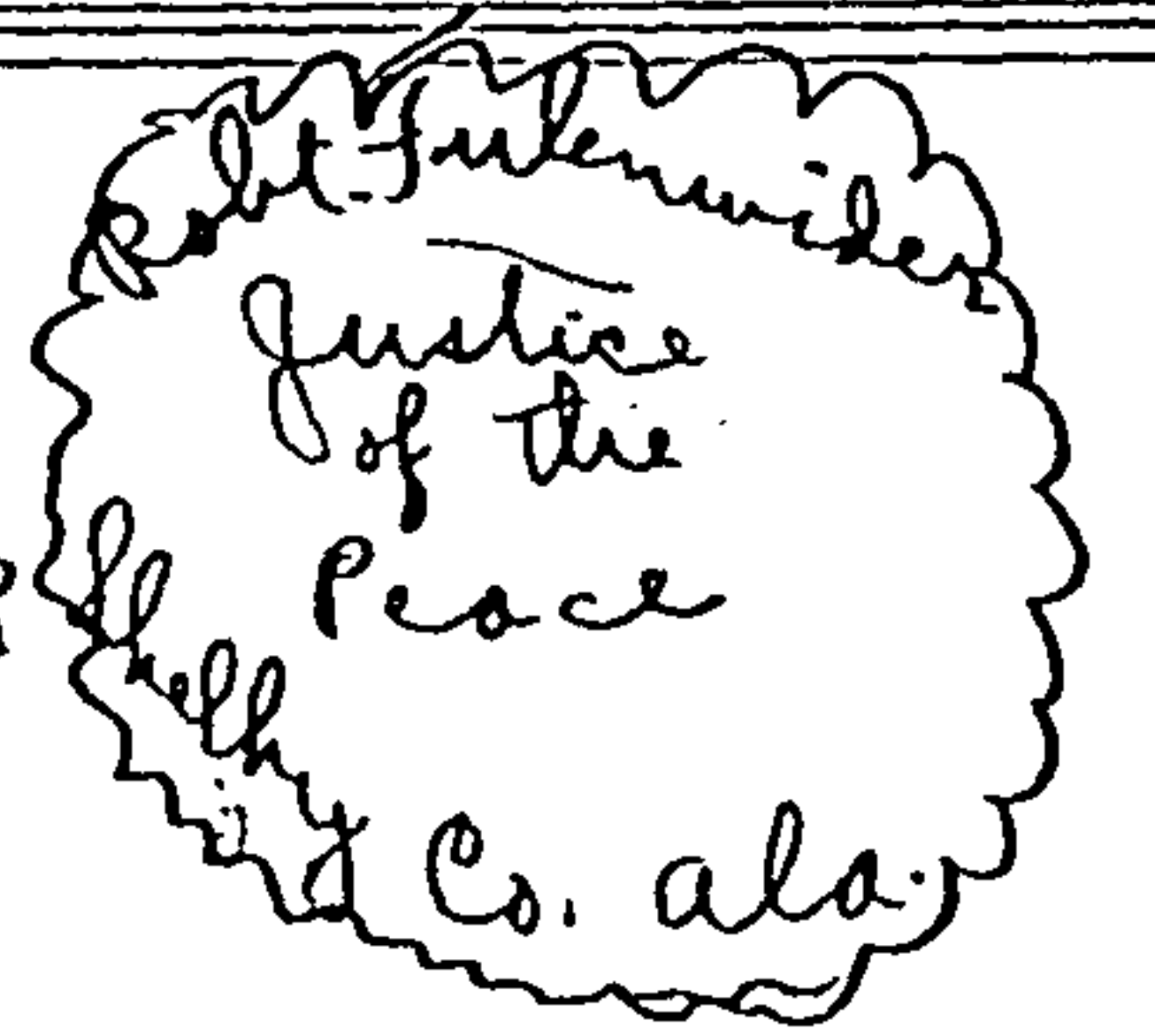
