The State of Alabama, } Know all men by these presents, that  
 Shelby County, } whereas, I, Wesley Ozley, the Administrator of  
 the estate of John N. Naish, deceased, by an order heretofore made  
 by the Probate Court of said County, on to-wit, the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Novem-  
 ber 1903, was authorized and empowered to sell and convey  
 certain real estate of said deceased, and whereas, in pursu-  
 ance of said order, and having given due and legal notice of the time,  
 place and terms of sale, by advertisement in the Peoples Advocate,  
 a newspaper published at Columbiana, Alabama, for three  
 successive weeks previous to said sale, I, as said Adminis-  
 trator, did, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of November 1903, at 12 o'clock M.,  
 sell at public outcry, to one Marshall B. Smith, who was the  
 highest best and last bidder, the said real estate, described  
 as follows: All of the North East quarter of the South West  
 quarter of Section eight, Township Twenty one of Range two  
 West, except ten acres off of the south end of same, also, all of  
 the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section eight,  
 Township twenty one Range 2 West, except ten acres off of the  
 North end of the same, all situated in the County of Shelby,  
 and State of Alabama, for the price of three hundred and  
 thirty-five dollars; and whereas, said sale has been by me,  
 as such administrator, duly reported to and confirmed by  
 order of said Probate Court, and the said Marshall B. Smith  
 has paid in cash the full amount of said purchase money,  
 which payment has been reported to said Court, and said Court  
 has ordered and decreed that titles be made to said Marshall  
 B. Smith for the said land so purchased by him and also re-  
 described. Now, therefore, by virtue of the premises, and in  
 consideration of said sum of three hundred and thirty-five  
 dollars, to me in hand paid by said Marshall B. Smith,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell, convey, transfer and set over to said Marshall  
 B. Smith, his heirs and assigns, all the right title, interest,  
 claim and demand, that said John N. Naish, at the time of his  
 death, had and held in and to the lands here inbefore described,  
 To have and to hold the said lands, to the said Marshall B. Smith,  
 his heirs and assigns forever. I in witness whereof, I as said  
 Administrator, do hereunto set my hand and seal this the 3<sup>rd</sup>  
 day of December 1903.
