JEFFERSON COUNTY ) Whereas on the 25th day of April, 1903, the undersigned grantors sold and conveyed unto Alexander T. London certain lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama, in the exercise of certain powers vested in them as Trustees of the estate of Horace Ware, deceased, and whereas the property hereinafter, described constituted and was a part of the land so sold as aforesaid, and whereas the deed conveying the land sold to the said Alexander T. London through mistake purported to convey an undivided one-half interest in and to the land hereinafter set out instead of the entire fee as was sold by these grantors to the said London.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, and for the purpose of correcting the mistake in said deed (to be found of record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County in book No. 28, page 517 record of Deeds) we the undersigned Jos. F. Johnston and Walter A. Smith, as Trustees under and by virtue of the powers vested in us as set out in said deed, do hereby grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Alexander T. London the following tracts of land to-wit, West half of north East quarter; and the south east quarter of the north east quarter and the East Half of the North West Quarter; and the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter and the North West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section 30, Township 21, Range 2 West. Also the West half of the South West Quarter and the North Half of the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter and the South West Quarter of the North West Quarter of said Section 30, Township 21, Range 2, West; and also the North East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section 25, Township 21, Range 3, West; all of the above described lands being situated in Shelby County Alabama, being that certain real estate an undivided half interest in which was conveyed to the said London by the deed executed on April 25, 1903, and mentioned above through mistake as herein shown, instead of the entire ~~interest~~ interest therein.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, unto the said Alexander T. London his heirs and assigns forever, without warranty of any kind on part of these grantors,

And we the undersigned do further confirm the conveyance in and by said deed to said London of an undivided one-half interest in and to the lands therein mentioned lying in Section Fourteen (14), Twenty Three (23), Twenty Four (24) and Thirteen (13) in Township 20, Range 1, West in said County and State.
