or elsewhere, hereby specially authorizing & empowering
him to sell rent or lease any or all of his said prop-
erty real or personal or sell or to mortgage or encumber
the same as he may see fit to sign for me & in my
name any notes receipts deeds, mortgages compro-
mises and any and all papers that may by him be
deemed necessary in the transactions of said bus-
iness or for the purpose of carrying out this mandate.
Hereby constituting him the said Silmer my general
& special agent & attorney in all matters in which
I have or may have any interest, hereby ratifying
any & all acts of my said agent and attorney in and
about the premises, he having full power in his said
capacity to act as fully & completely as if I myself was
personally present & signing my name. He further
declared that he revoked all previous powers of attor-
ney given to any one or for any purpose whatsoever.
