Shelby County. I presents, that for and in con-
sideration of One Hundred Dollars to the under-
signed grantor, L. C. O'Barr in hand paid by Gulf
Red Cedar Company the receipt whereof is acknowl-
edged & the said L. C. O'Barr do grant bargain
sell and convey unto the said Gulf Red Cedar
Company the following described, to-wit: all Cedar
timber above six inches in diameter 12 inches
from the ground. Also the right of way on and
over said premises to cut such roads as may
be necessary to remove said timber from
the premises and the said L. C. O'Barr reserves
all the logs and waste timber which may be
cut in taking the above timber from the prem-
ises. The said timber being purchased off of
the following lands to-wit: All that part of
the W¹/₂ of S W¹/₄ Sec. 25 all that part of the
east half of the South East ¹/₄ of Section 26.
All in T. 20 Range 3 west that lies west of
the South and North Alabama Rail Road.
The said timber to be removed from the
land within twelve (12) months from the
date of this deed. Situated in Shelby
County Alabama.
To have and to hold to the said Gulf Red
Cedar Company, their heirs and assigns
forever.
And I do for myself and my heirs executors
and administrators covenant with the
said Gulf Red Cedar Company their
heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully
seized in full simple of said premises,
that they be free from all encum-
brances, that I have a good right to
sell and convey the same as aforesaid;
that I will and my heirs, executors
and administrators shall warrant and
defend the same to the said Gulf Red
Cedar Company, their heirs and assigns

forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

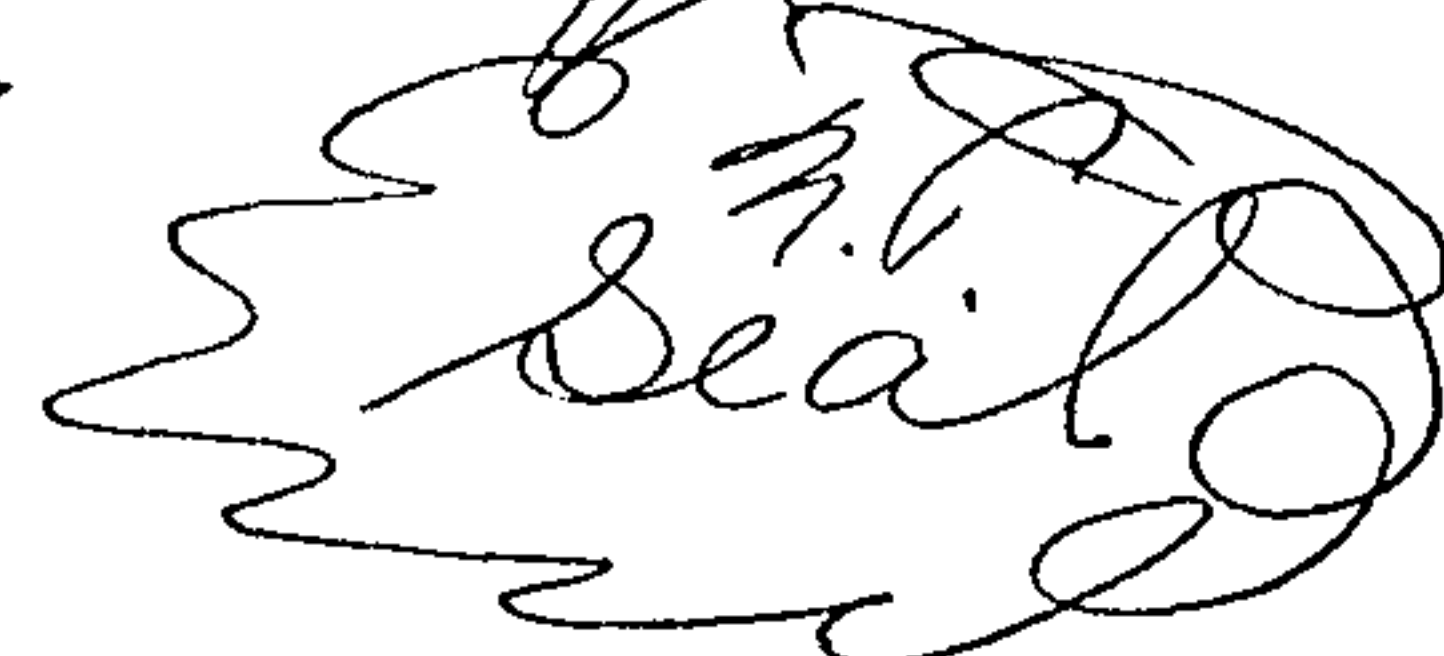
