 sold, aliened, enfeoffed and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell,
 enfeoff and convey to the said Rachel Stedman, all that certain track or parcel of land
 lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, and more particularly
 described as follows, to wit; Beginning at the WEST Corner of said Rachel Stedman lot
 and running North to the South West corner of Henry O'hara's lot thence East to a branch
 thence South with said branch to the line of Alf Barnetts lot thence Westerly to the

 and hereby granted premises unto the said party of the second part her heirs and ~~and~~

 them, the said party of the first part, and against the lawful claims or demands of
^{and every} all person whosoever, claiming or holding by, from or under the Government of the
