 this the 25th day of March, 1905, by and between James
 H. Alexander and his wife, Amanda T. Alexander, J. W.
 Ingram and his wife, I. J. Ingram, and Mary W. Scho-
 field a widow, parties of the first part, and Benj.
 R. Alexander, party of the second part, witnesses; whereas,
 said James H. Alexander, I. J. Ingram, Mary W. Scho-
 field and Benj. Alexander are the only heirs at
 law of Catherine Alexander, their mother, deceased;
 and whereas said party of the second part, cared for
 and supported and maintained the said Catherine
 Alexander during the latter years of her life, with
 the understanding that the land hereinafter conveyed,
 heretofore belonging to said Catherine Alexander,
 would at her death, for and in consideration of
 his said services, be conveyed by said parties of
 the first part to said party of the second part,
