Six hundred dollars to her in hand paid,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
said party of the first part has granted, bar-
gained, sold, and does by these presents
grant bargain, sell and convey unto
said party of the second part, the follow-
ing described real estate lying and being
in said Shelby County state of Alabama,
to-wit: The NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 (except four (4)
acres in the northwest corner thereof, her-
etofore sold to one Richard Jones, and
known as the "Jones lot", the said four acres
being one acre wide east and west, and
four acres long north and south) also
the N-1/2 of NE-1/4 of the SW-1/4, all in section
four (4), township twenty-two (22) South,
Range three (3) West and known as "the
Ozley place" at Hogwood, Ala. To have and
to hold, together with all rights and sin-
gular the rights, privileges, tenements
and hereditaments therein to belong to
or appertaining, unto said party of the
second part his heirs and assigns forever
but subject to the use and occupation
of Bird Borden, the tenant of said party

of the first part, for the current year.
 And said party of the first part hereby con-
 sents with said party of the second part that
 with the limitation above mentioned, she is
 lawfully seized of the aforegranted premises;
 that she has a good right to sell and convey
 the same, and that she will warrant and
 defend the title to the same to said party of
 the second part, his heirs and assigns against
 the lawful claim or demands of any and
 all persons whomsoever, either at law or in
 equity.
