

This Indenture made this 12th day of January 1887
 between N. E. Brinkerhoff of the town of Oxford,
 County of Calhoun, State of Ala. of the first part, and
 Jane, wife of Thomas J. Francis of Calera, Shelby
 County Ala State of Alabama of the second part,
 Witnesseth, that the party of the first part, in consid-
 eration of the sum of One hundred and fifty 00/100
 dollars to him paid by the party of the second
 part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 doth hereby grant, bargain sell and convey unto
 the said party of the second part the following
 described real estate, to-wit: That certain tract
 of parcel of lands commencing at a point distant
 five hundred and forty five and six tenths
 (545 6/10) feet, due South from the present point
 of intersection of Smith and Calera streets, run-
 ning North or and along the East side of and
 fronting on said Calera Street Eighty two (82)
 feet by a depth of One hundred and seventy-
 four and one fourth (174 1/4) feet. Between par-
 allel lines, said tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the North East quarter of the
 North East quarter of Section Three (3) Township
 Twenty four (24) of Range (3) Thirteen East, in
 the town of Calera, County of Shelby and
 State of Alabama. To have and to hold to
 the said Jane Francis her heirs and assigns
 forever. And the party of the first part will
 forever warrant and defend the title to the
 same to the said party of the second part
 and to her representatives and assigns from
 every lawful claim whatever.
