 presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
 party of the second part the following described real
 estate lying in the county of Shelby State of Alabama
 to-wit $1/8$ of $SW 1/4$ and $NE 1/4$ of the $SE 1/4$ of Section
 (8) eight in Township twenty two (22) of Range one (1) west
 to have and to hold, to the said party of the second
 part and to his heirs and assigns forever, and
 said Sarah Jasper, Richard, Bettie Benf. J. Jas H. H. &
 Burrel, of the first part covenant with the said
 Thomas Halcomb, of the second part that they are
 lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that
 they are free from all incumbrances and that they
 have a good right to sell, and convey the same, that
 they will and their heirs executors and administrators
 shall warrant and defend the same said Thomas
 Halcombe of the second part and his heirs and assigns
 forever against the lawful claims of all persons
