ourselves, and our heirs executors and administrators covenant  
with the said George W. Eason, and his heirs and assigns, that  
we, are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that  
they are free from all incumbrances; that we have a good  
right to sell and convey the said property; that we  
will, and our heirs executors and administrators shall  
warrant and defend the same to said George W. Eason.
