 for the consideration of the sum of two hundred
 and thirty dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, and the said party of the first

 Russell all their entire right and interest in the
 above described land by assigning this quit claim
 deed and the party of the first part will warrant
 and defend all and any interest that any person
 or persons may set up against said land for
 we as heirs will all our right to said N. Russell
 his heirs &c.
