

Whereas, on, to-wit, the 14th day of November, 1899, Charles Schiff and W. W. Bond, as Trustees, conveyed the lands hereinafter described, among other lands, to the undersigned, the Alabama State Land Company, in trust for the uses and purposes in said trust deed declared, and which conveyance is recorded in Deed Record Vol. 264, Page 1, Jefferson County, Alabama, And whereas, said the Alabama State Land Company, as Trustee above mentioned, has this day sold to R. F. Wendell, of Jefferson County, Alabama, the iron ore, coal and other minerals contained in and upon the parcel or parcels of land, hereinafter particularly described, with all necessary privileges for mining on said lands, at and for the price of Eight hundred (\$800.00) dollars, upon the terms herein shown, that is to say, the said R. F. Wendell has this day paid to the Alabama State Land Company as Trustee as aforesaid, the sum of Eight hundred (\$800.00) dollars in cash. Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, the Alabama State Land Company, as Trustee, under and by virtue of the authority in it vested by the terms of the

above described conveyance from Charles Schiff & N. N. Bond, Trustees, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said R. F. Wendell, the said Iron ore, Coal and other Minerals and mining privileges in and upon the following described lands, situated in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, to-wit:

The East half of the North West quarter of Section twenty Township Eighteen South, Range one West, E 1/2 of NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 18 S. Range 1 West. Containing Eighty (80) acres, more or less. To have and to hold the said Iron ore, Coal and other minerals and Mining privileges above described unto the said R. F. Wendell, his heirs and assigns forever.

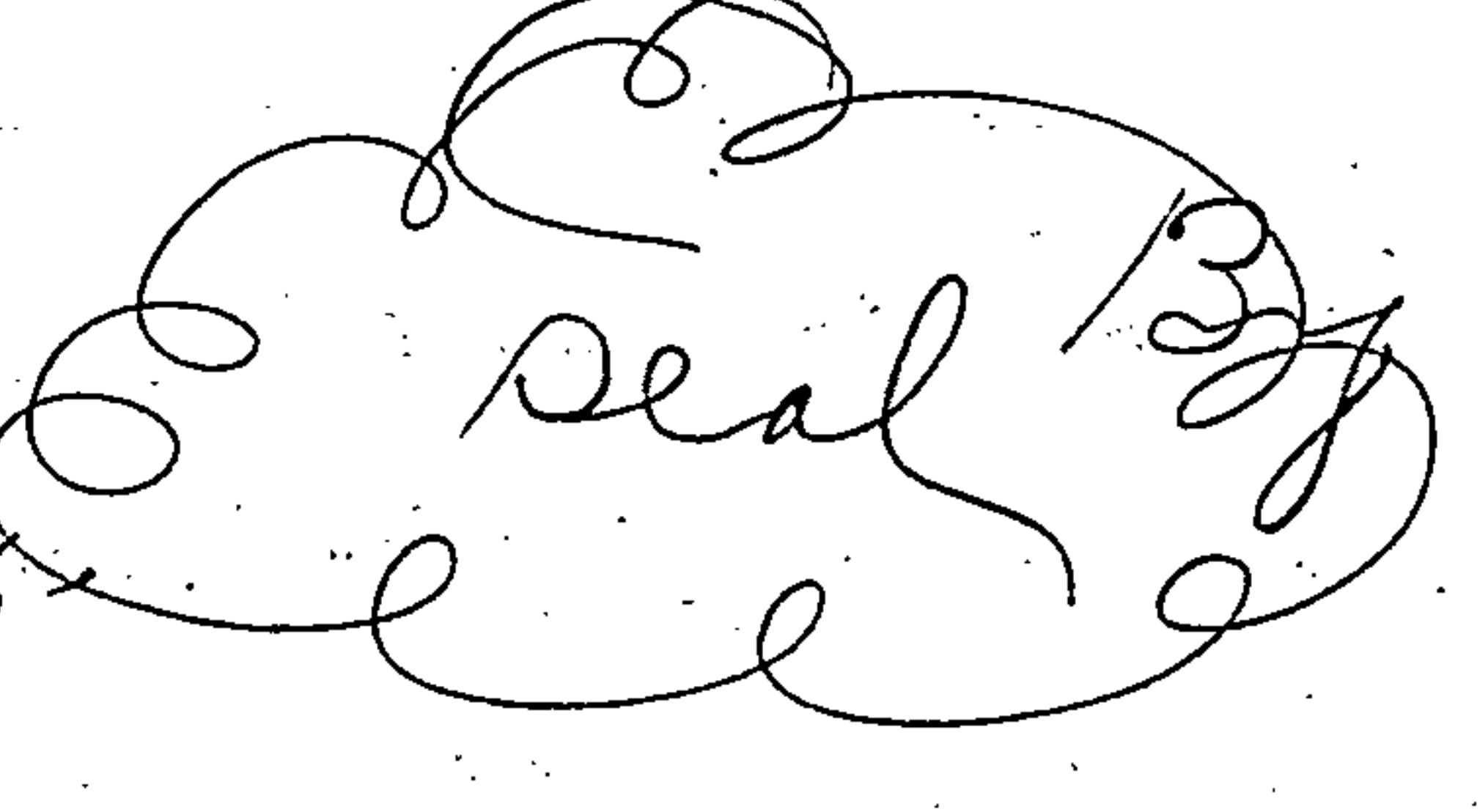
