

This Indenture made and entered into this the  
 twentieth day of March, in the year of our Lord  
 One Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty-two  
 between John N. Sudbury and his wife Susan  
 of the County of Nowak and State of Miss.  
 of the one part and Malden Roy of the County  
 of Shelby and State of Alabama of the other  
 part, Witnesseth, that the said John N. Sudbury  
 and his wife Susan have bargained, sold and  
 delivered unto unto the said Malden Roy a  
 certain parcel or tract of Land, lying and  
 being in the County of Shelby and State of Ala-  
 bama aforesaid, as follows. The East half of  
 the South East quarter of Section ten, in Township  
 twenty and of Range three West, except so much

of the North end of said half quarter as the Spring Branch running East cut off, supposed to be thirty acres more or less, I deeded to Needham Lee, also all of the North East quarter of Section fifteen which lies North of Buck Creek and five acres more or less of the S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  all of the same Section, Township and Range, and the said John N. Sudbury and his wife Susan doth for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators forever warrant and defend all their right, title and interest in the above described lands to the said Malden Roy, from and his heirs forever, Our testimony whereof we have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first above written.
