 Thomas B. Miller of said County & State,
 party of the second part; Witnesseth, that
 the said parties of the first part, for and in
 consideration of the sum of one Hundred
 dollars to us in hand paid by the said
 party of the second part, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said parties
 of the first part have bargained and sold,
 and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell
 and convey, unto the said party of the
 second part, the following described real
 estate lying in the County of Shelly
 State of Alabama, to wit:

East half of North west fourth section
 thirty in township 14 South of range two
 west containing seventy nine and ninety
 five hundredths of acre. To have and to
 hold to the said party of the second part,
 and to his heirs and assigns forever. And
 said York Reeves & ——— parties of
 the first part covenant with the said
 Thomas B. Miller of the second part, that
 we are lawfully seized in fee simple of
 of said premises; that they are free from
 all incumbrances, and that we have
 a good right to sell and convey the same;
 that we will and our heirs, execu-
 tors and administrators shall warrant
 and defend the same to said Thomas
 B. Miller party of the second part, and
 his heirs and assigns forever against the
 lawful claims of all persons.
