 the east half of south west quarter section Three, Town-  
 ship Twenty two Range two west, (E  $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec 3 T 22 R 2 W.)  
 Also the north half of the north west quarter (N  $\frac{1}{2}$  of  
 NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  & SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  & SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec 10 T 22 R 2 West.
