For and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I Allen Wilson of the County and State aforesaid of the first part do hereby sell and convey unto John P. Pearson of the second part all my right, title and interest to the following described land to wit, The west half of the Southwest quarter of Section fifteen Township 18 in Range one West, also a part of SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of same section Township and Range beginning at the South East corner of said quarter & running the north line to the main road thence south of west with said road to the section line and also two acres more or less, North of said Road, beginning at a pine bush near the road running a N West course to two small red oak trees marked thus X thence north the main Road NE direction to a chestnut stake near a hollow, thence to red oak marked thus X thence to the beginning

Also the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of same Section Township and Range a part of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of said quarter section described as follows beginning at the South West corner of said quarter and running the North line to near into the North West corner of the said quarter to a cross fence thence SE direction along said fence to the South line thence West to the beginning, Also the $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22 Township 18, Range 1 West in the Tuscaloosa Land District, Alabama Together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging & warrant and defend the title to said John P. Pearson, his heirs and assigns forever.
