 R. B. Moore, Trustees as aforesaid, and to their succes-
 sors in office, for use of the Methodist Protestant Church,
 Alabama Conference, the following described property, to-wit:
 Beginning at the Southeast corner of what is known as the
 Union Church lot, thence in an easterly direction seventy
 yards, thence north seventy yards, thence west
 seventy yards, thence south to point of beginning;
 also that lot or parcel of land described as follows: -
 Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Union Church
 lot, thence north seventy yards, thence west seventy
 yards, thence south to line of said Church lot, thence
