 I have this day, for and in Consideration of fifty dollars, to me in hand paid by Geo. B. Randolph, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Geo. B. Randolph the right and option to purchase within six months from this date, at the price and sum of fifteen hundred dollars, the following described lands in said County and State, to-wit: The South half of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$, and the South half of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ in Section twenty three (23) Township 19 South of Range 2 East in Shelby County Alabama. At any time prior to the expiration of the said six months, if the said Geo. B. Randolph, shall pay or cause to be paid, to the said F. E. Thompson the said sum of Fifteen hundred dollars, as the purchase money of said lands, then the said Geo. B. Randolph hereby binds themselves, their heirs and assigns to prepare and deliver to the said Geo. B. Randolph or to any other party or parties that he may name, a deed in fee simple, conveying said lands to said Geo. B.
