— — — — — all that certain tract or parcel of land lying ^{and} being in the County of Shelby ^{of} State of Alabama, ^{and} more particularly described as follows to wit: The East half of the North west fourth of the North East fourth of section one township nineteen (19) range two East containing twenty two acres.

Now the undersigned desires to make this man Wiley Kidd a deed of gift of the above described twenty acres of land. Therefore he Wiley Kidd therefore he has a perfect right to do as he thinks best with the above twenty acres of land. To Have ^{and} to hold, The above described tract or parcel of land, together with the tenements ^{and} appurtenances there to belonging, or otherwise appertaining, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs ^{and} assigns forever. And the said B. F. Glover of the first part, for themselves, his heirs, executors ^{and} administrators do warrant ^{and} will forever defend the title to the above described ^{and} hereby granted premises unto the said party of the second part, his heirs ^{and} assigns, from ^{and} against themselves, ^{and} all ^{and} every person claiming or holding under them, the said party of the first part, ^{and} against the lawful title, claim or demand of all ^{and} every person whomsoever, claiming or holding by, from or under the Government of the United States.
