One lot in the town of Columbiana described and bounded as follows: Commencing at the Northeast Corner of the residence lot of Max Lefkowitz, on the West side of Main Street in said town and running North along said Street one hundred and fifty-five (155) feet to Sterrett Street; thence in a westerly direction along the South side of said Sterrett Street four hundred and seventy-two (472) feet to an Alley; thence running in a southerly direction along said Alley one hundred and forty-nine (149) feet to the Northwest Corner of said Max Lefkowitz lot; thence in an Easterly direction along the North side of said Max Lefkowitz lot four hundred and twenty-five (425) feet to the point of beginning. The said lot herein conveyed prior to this conveyance being the property of the Columbiana Mercantile Company, a firm composed of the said Max Lefkowitz and the said Philip Erdlich and this conveyance being made to convey to the said Philip Erdlich the undivided one-half interest of the said Max Lefkowitz.
