 in hand paid by Hallett K. Macknight, the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
 do, by these presents, bargain, sell and con-
 vey to the said Hallett K. Macknight, his
 executors, administrators and assigns,
 all of my right, title and interest in the said
 "Columbiana Sentinel", to the amount of four-
 fifths of the stock of said newspaper plant,
 which said stock - 225 shares out of a total
 of 281 shares - is hereby transferred to the said
 Hallett K. Macknight, To have and to hold
 the same forever. And I, the said H. E.
 Whitaker, do promise, covenant and agree,
 for myself, his heirs and executors, to and
 with the said Hallett K. Macknight, to war-
 rant and defend the title of the said
 225 shares of the said "Columbiana Sentinel"
 against all and every person and persons
 whomsoever.
