 the second part we sell and convey all
 the pine timber ten inches and a bone and
 side of plantation to eighteen inches
 above the ground the said J.B. Turners is to have
 to the 23 day of March 1910 to cut and re-
 move the said timber said forty to wit:
 NN¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ Sec 3 Tp 19 R 12N, forty of
 first part agrees for forty of second
 part to have drag roads to remove
 said timber except through plantation
 lying and situated in Shelby County,
 Ala; this contract becomes null and

void on the twenty third day of march
1910, witness our hand and seal this 23
of march 1907
