 Peace, in and for Shelly County, E. R. Isbell
 who being sworn, says that he has acquainted
 with Matto Tomponie the grantee in a deed by
 F. B. and Catherine and John J. Lee conveying the
 following described real estate, commencing at the
 half mile line running south to the top of said
 Ridge, thence the top of said ridge one half mile,
 thence one quarter to the N. E. Corner of S. E. 1/4 of S. N. 1/4,
 thence one half mile to the starting point. S. E. 26 -
 Township 17 - Range 1 East. Containing one hundred
 acres more or less - the N. 1/2 of S. N. 1/4, 20 acres on
 North side of S. 1/2 of S. N. 1/4 Sec. 26, Township 17, Range
 1 East, situated in Shelly County, said deed dated
 August 22-1891 - Deed Book 20 - Page 96 - He
 testifies that this Matto Tomponie is the same per-
 son who conveyed to him, E. R. Isbell by a deed
 dated Jan. 29th 1899, Book 25 - Page 82, the fol-
 lowing lands commencing at half mile stake or
 line running south to top of said ridge, thence along
 top of said ridge east one half mile - thence North
 1/4 of a mile to the North East Corner of S. N. - of - N. 1/4
 thence one half mile to point of beginning, Sec 26. Tp.
 17 R. 1 East, Containing one hundred acres more or
 less, N. 1/2 of S. N. 1/4 and 20 acres upon North side
 of S. 1/2 of S. N. 1/4, Section 26 - Tp 17 R. 1 East situated in
 Shelly County Alabama, that the spelling of the
 name was a mistake in writing the paper, also
 further testifies that he is the person to whom this
 property was conveyed but was known both as R.
 Isbell and E. R. Isbell.
