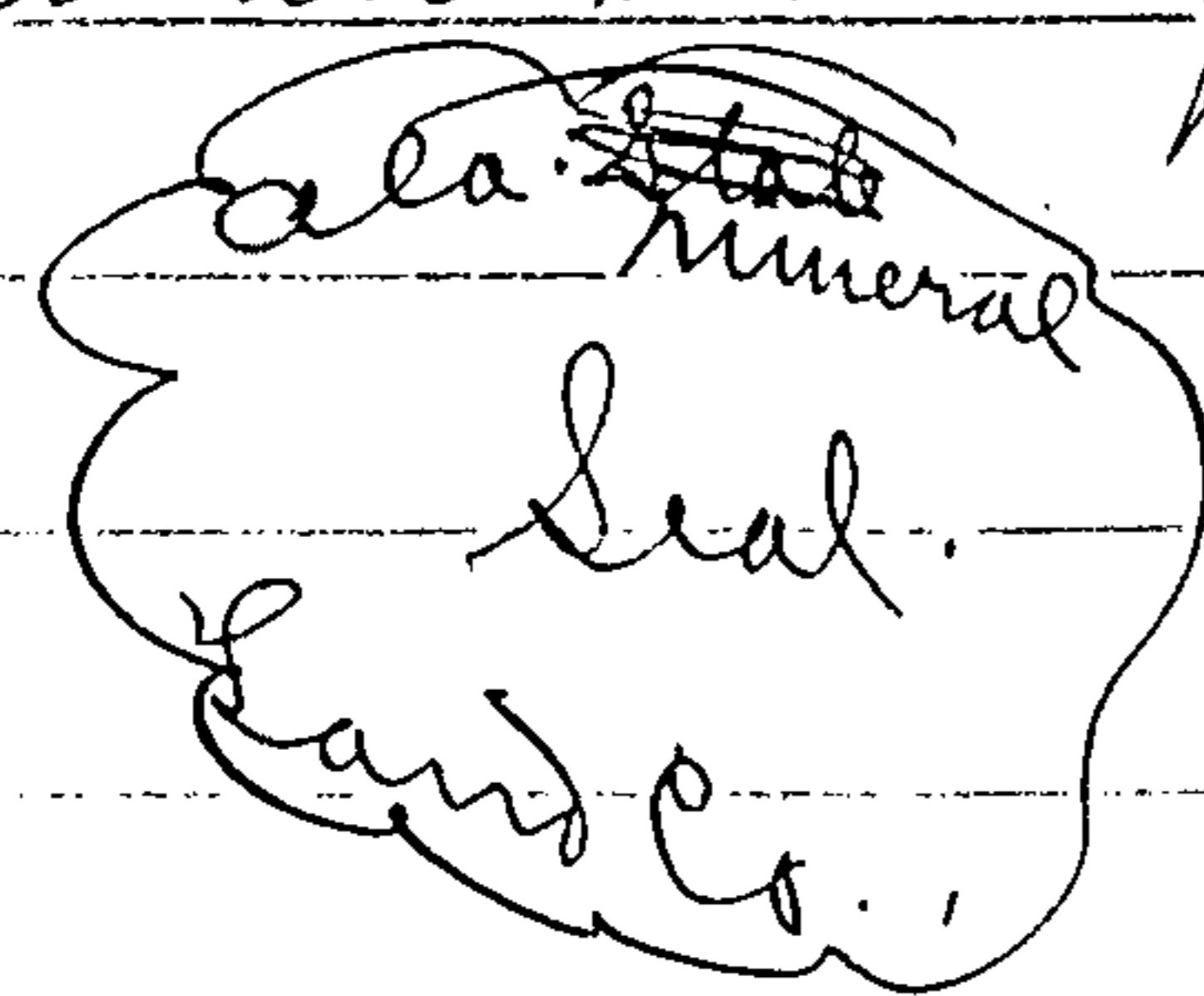

To Have and to Hold the said described land, together with any tenements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging, to said Justin L. Jackson, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever.
