 give, grant, bargain, sell, and convey to the said  
 Alice West and L. F. West, their heirs and assigns, all  
 the tract in under and upon the following described  
 land lying in Shelby County, Alabama, to wit: - Beginning  
 at a bayou at the south end of the oak ridge  
 from thence, in an easterly direction along the foot  
 of said ridge to the farm road of L. F. West, from  
 thence along the west side of said road, in a norther-  
 ly direction, to the corner of said West fence, from thence  
 in a straight line to Gilbert's line, thence along said  
 line to the corner, thence west to the top of the  
 mountain, and thence along the top of said moun-  
 tain to the beginning point; part in the S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$   
 of S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 13, and part in the W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the
