 hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the State of
 Alabama for the benefit Public School District No. 37 of Shelby
 County, Alabama, the following described parcel of land
 lying and being in Section seven, Township twenty-four,
 Range thirten East, in said Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:
 two acres of land lying in the south-east corner of the
 North half of the South-east quarter of the north-west
 quarter of said section seven, the same to be seventy
 yards in width north and south, and one hundred and
 forty yards in length east and west, and extending from
 the east line of said SE-1/4 of NW-1/4 to the east line of the
 Even Baptist Church lot, and lying along the south
 line of the said N-1/2 of SE-1/4 of said NW-1/4 of Section
 seven, for public school purposes. To have and to hold,
 together with all and singular the rights, privileges,
 tenements and hereditaments thereunto belonging or ap-
 pertaining unto the State of Alabama for the benefit
