

The State of Alabama, Know all men by these  
 Shelby County Presents, That whereas I,  
 Collins Fluker as the administrator of the estate  
 of Moses Fluker Deceased, duly appointed by and  
 qualified in the Probate Court of said County,  
 heretofore applied for, and on the 19<sup>th</sup> day  
 of April 1909, obtained an order and decree  
 of said court for the sale of lands described  
 as follows, viz: The North-East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the

south East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 22 in Township 21 of Range  
 1 East in said county, which lands were sold  
 by said administrator under and in pursuance

 made by said administrator to said purchaser  
 thereof according to law.

Now therefore, This instrument witnesseth,  
 that the said Collins Flucker as such admin-  
 istrator as aforesaid, hath in accordance with  
 the order of said Court, conveyed and confirmed,  
 and by this instrument doth convey and  
 confirm unto the said John S. Stone his  
 heirs and assigns forever, all claim, right, ti-  
 tle and interest which the said Moses Flucker  
 Deceased, had at the time of his death in and  
 to the lands aforesaid.
